

# Government of Japan (MEXT) Scholarship for Teacher-Training Student for 2020

## Notes for Application and Schedule of the Selection

The MEXT (Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology, Government of Japan) offers scholarship to foreign teachers who wish to conduct research on school education at Japanese universities under the Japanese Government (MEXT) Scholarship Program for 2020.

Please note that this is NOT A SCHOLARSHIP FOR A DEGREE PROGRAM and NOT EXTENDABLE.

### 1. Outline of the Scholarship

- (1) Term of Scholarship: October 2020 to March 2022 (Note: it is not extendable.)
- (2) Qualifications (**\*Please refer to Application Guideline enclosed for all details.**)
  - Nationality: Egyptian
  - Age: Under 35 years old of age as of April 1, 2020 (born after April 2, 1985)
  - Academic Background: Graduates of universities or teacher training college currently working as teacher in primary or secondary school, or as academic staff at teacher training institutions who have at least 5-years experience in their terms of service, as of April 1, 2020

#### (3) Third Stage: Interview (\*only for applicants who have passed the second stage)

- Date and Place: Wednesday, 4 March, 2020 (scheduled)

- Interview Result Announcement: Thursday, 5 March, 2020 (scheduled)
